### **New Services**

The following services are available for our patients

- **Wellbeing and Self Care Service**

Self Care Coordinators provide this service every Thursday afternoon and Saturday morning at the practice for patients aged 18+ to help manage the things in your life that may affect your health and wellbeing.

- **First Contact Practitioner (FCP)**

An assessment & advice service for new joint, bone or muscle problems. Appointments are available every Wednesday at the practice.

- **Weekend Appointments**

Appointments are available at the weekends to see a GP, Practice Nurse or HCA. Appointments are booked via the practice (by telephone only) but will be held at our local hub Gatley Medical Centre. With consent the clinician will have access to your medical record and can organise for tests and referrals if necessary.
